Farmworker Housing Summit participants commented on some of the other issues concerning farmworker housing in the Pajaro Valley. Participants made the following comments:

- Create an opportunity for farmworkers to own their home rather than rent.
- Ensure that the cost of the housing is affordable to farmworkers.
- Provide adequate maintenance of housing in order to keep it safe and sanitary (without rodents).
- Consider the urgent nature of the current housing situation for farmworkers and respond as soon as possible.
